Belana has medium demands to the soil and water supply. Good agricultural conditions as well as uniform water and nutrient supply are advantageous. Soils with very high risk of spraying should be avoided.

Belana has a very good dormancy. In order to enhance development chitting or at least sprouting induction in time is urgently recommended.

Belana has high tuberisation rate, recommended plant density is approx. 40,000 plants/ha. Chitted as well as very good sprouting stimulated tubers should be planted slightly deeper (approx. 2 cm) than usual.

Belana forms very nice, uniform and very tasty tubers. This premium salad potato is excellent suitable for packing and convenience products.
