resistance to nematodes	:	Ro 1 + Ro 4

Y-Virus (PVY)	:	good

tuber late blight ( <i>Phytophthora infestans</i> )	:	good resistant
internal rust spots	:	good
processing quality	:	none
sensitivity to mechanical damage	:	low (esp. for a salad type variety)
dormancy	:	very good storability

**SIMONE** is a potentially high yielding salad type, firm cooking variety which prefers a good soil structure and regular water and nutrients supply.

**SIMONE** has a good, aromatic taste and good storability (will not produce reducing sugar while stored under cooler conditions)

**SIMONE** has a rather slow juvenile development, but will catch up, should be planted with 30 – 32 cm in the 75 cm row and 2 – 3 cm deeper than standard

**SIMONE** is low susceptible to mechanical damage and late blight infection and should be planted on better soils (also to reduce risk of scab).
