Augusta has medium to high demands to soil and water supply. Good soil structure is advantageous.

Augusta is growing medium sized tubers. Due to medium tuberisation rate the recommended plant density is approx. 46,000 plants/ha. Attention should be paid on sufficient supply of potassium and magnesium.

Augusta has a good field resistance to late blight. However, regular protective chemical control of late blight is recommended.

Augusta is a high yielding flourey cooking quality ware potato with nice shaped tubers and good storability.
