Site requirements	medium to high demands to soil and water supply, soils with uniform water supply should be preferred		
Planting	planting density	approx. 39.000 plants/ha; seed size 35/55 mm => check QR Code for more details	
	planting depth	normal compared with local standard	
	seed preparation	careful induction of sprouting before planting is recommended (3 - 4 days) - sensitive to broken sprouts	
	seed treatment	could be sensitive to some ingredients – ask adviser	
Foliage	routine protective control of late blight is recommended		
Herbicides	sensitive to Metribuzin, especially post emergence application should be avoided		
Harvest	Bellinda needs some days more to get set skin
