Growing recommendations		
<b>Site requirements</b>	preferably grown on medium soils with uniform water and nutrient supply	
<b>Planting</b>	planting density	approx. 41,000 plants/ha (seed size 35/55 mm) => check QR Code for more details
	planting depth	normal
	seed preparation	application of temperature shock before planting is recommended for early harvest
	seed dressing	preventive control of <i>Rhizoctonia</i> is generally recommended
<b>Foliage</b>	good - protective control of late blight within the usual spraying program is recommended	
<b>Herbicides</b>	slightly sensitive to Metribuzin, especially post emergence application should be avoided

<b>Nitrogen</b>	medium - compared to local standard	
<b>Phosphorus</b>	100 kg/ha (at planting, water soluble phosphate)	
<b>Potassium</b>	200 - 250 kg/ha	
<b>Magnesium</b>	60 kg/ha
