Eurotango has medium demands to soil and some tolerance to drought. However, uniform water and nutrient supply is advantageous.

Eurotango has a high tuberization rate, the recommended planting density is approx. 40,000 plant/ha. Due to late maturity nitrogen fertilization should be slightly reduced (approx. 10 - 15% less than local standard).

Eurotango ensures high starch yield and productivity of starch potato production due to the very high level of resistance and tolerances to pests and diseases.
