- attractive long-oval uniform tuber shape
- very early to early maturity
- yellow flesh colour
- excellent culinary quality

**Glorietta** is a quality salad variety with nice long-oval tubers and excellent taste.

<b>Growing recommendations</b>		
<b>Site requirements</b>	preferably grown on medium to good soils with uniform water and nutrient supply	
<b>Planting</b>	planting density	approx. 46,000 plants/ha (seed size 35/55 mm)
	planting depth	approx. 2 cm deeper than normal (high deposition of tubers), if applicable; however, final soil coverage should not exceed 17 cm
	seed preparation	temperature shock 3 days before planting; sprout breaking has to be avoided
	seed dressing	preventive control of <i>Rhizoctonia solani</i> is generally recommended
<b>Foliage</b>	routine protective control of late blight is recommended	
<b>Herbicides</b>	no sensitivities known	
<b>Fertilization</b>		<b>further information</b>
<b>Nitrogen</b>	low-medium - compared with local standard	
<b>Phosphorus</b>	100 kg/ha (at planting, water soluble phosphate)	
<b>Potassium</b>	200 - 250 kg/ha (at medium soil supply class), only potassium sulphate should be used in case of	
<b>Magnesium</b>	60 kg/ha
