Tomensa has low to medium demands to the soil and humidity.

Tomensa has a medium tuberization rate; the recommended planting density is approx. 46,000 plant/ha. Due to good dormancy good sprouting stimulation is recommended.

Tomensa has low content of reducing sugars and a very good crisp quality.

Tomensa should be harvested and handled carefully in order to sustain the very good product quality.
